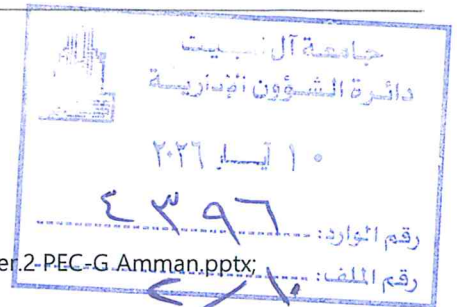

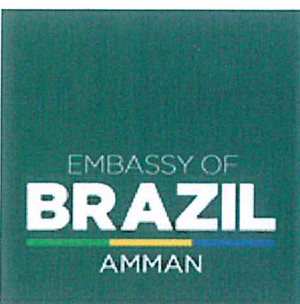

Dear Mr. President of University,

The Embassy of the Federative Republic of Brazil in Amman presents its compliments to the esteemed University and has the honour to communicate that Brazil would like to have Jordanian students enrol in its Program for Exchange Students - Undergraduate Level (PEC-G) and in its Program for Exchange Students – Portuguese as a Foreign Language (PEC-PLE).

2. The Embassy of the Federative Republic of Brazil in Amman highlights the importance of our countries cooperating on cultural and educational matters, of which PEC-G and PEC-PLE are great examples. Both programs offer unique opportunities to prospective Jordanian students such as:

- High quality education: Brazil is home to several top-ranked universities in Latin America;
- Cultural Diversity: Brazil offers a unique and diverse cultural experience that will enhance students' global perspective and intercultural skills;
- Language Skills: learning and improving their proficiency in Portuguese, one of the most spoken languages in the world;
- International Networking: meeting students, teachers and professionals from all over the world;
- Free of Charge: international students can study in Brazil completely free of charge, through the PEC-G program.

3. In addition, the following benefits are extended to all foreign students participating in the program:

- Free admission for complete undergraduate course;
- In some cases, the Brazilian Government may offer scholarships to help cover living expenses.

4. Furthermore, the Embassy of Brazil is very glad to convey the information that several other countries within the region have joined the program such as Iran, Lebanon, Pakistan, Syria and Turkey.

5. The main requirements for joining both programs (PEC-G and PEC-PLE) are as follows:

- Prospective students should be at least 18 years old by the date defined in the Call Notice for applications;
- They should meet the stipulated Portuguese language requirements if they are applying to PEC-G (full undergrad course of studies);
- Applicants who do not meet the attested required level of Portuguese, can apply to study Portuguese as a Foreign Language (PEC-PLE) first that would qualify them to apply later to an undergraduate course (PEC-G); and
- Applicants should have a sponsor who can attest they have sufficient income to cover the student's living expenses in Brazil.

6. In order to promote the aforementioned programs, the Embassy of Brazil is glad to forward the attached press material and asks that the good offices of the esteemed University to share it with relevant partners and promote it among the students of your institution. Further information about the application processes for both programs is available in this material.

7. The Embassy of the Federative Republic of Brazil in Amman avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the esteemed University the assurances of its highest consideration and esteem.
